Our phone volunteers are passionate about helping them gain a good understanding of what Al-Anon can offer in terms of help and support. The opportunity to hear about the program from someone who's been there may well influence the caller to seek recovery in Al-Anon, and therein lies the reward for all.

What's Required

Minimum of 6 months in Al-Anon.

Regularly attend meetings.

Commit to answer calls for one week* each month, along with four other volunteers.

**Monday thru Sunday, 8am-9pm*

Have a computer with internet service.
